The session commenced with welcome speech by Dr. Sweta P. Dave (Principal-GEC, Gandhinagar) and explained the objectives and importance of the lecture. The lecture dealt with marginality of women drawn out of statistical information, the kind of problems faced by women in cases of crime against women and types of legal remedies used to put such crimes to an end. Students were made aware of the different laws for crimes like female foeticide, rape, kidnapping, dowry deaths or attempts, torture both mental and physical assault on women with intent to outrage her modesty, honour killings etc. faced by both rural and urban women in India.
