## **Report on Seminar: Bridging Circuits to Civics – UPSC/GPSC Journey for Engineers**

A seminar on 'Bridging Circuits to Civics: UPSC/GPSC Journey for Engineers' was organized by Government Engineering College, Gandhinagar on 6th September 2025 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM at C. V.
